Anna Tramontano is a member of the Scientific Council of Istituto Pasteur-Fondazione Cenci Bolognetti. She trained as a physicist but soon became fascinated by the complexity of biology and the promises of computational biology. After working at the Department of Biochemistry at San Francisco University, California, and in the Biocomputing Programme of the European Molecular Biology Laboratory in Heidelberg, she moved back to Italy to work at the Merck Research Laboratories. She later returned to the academic world as a chair professor of Biochemistry at Sapienza University of Rome, where she continues to pursue her scientific interests on protein structure prediction and analysis.
